



## ***A Mountainside Remembrance: 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the military plane crash on Garnet Peak in Peru, MA***

Join the Town of Peru, The Peru Historical Commission, and Friends of Peru State Forest for a 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary remembrance of the WWII plane crash on August 15<sup>th</sup>, 1942.

Sixteen brave young men lost their lives in the crash. The remembrance will be held on-site at the memorial in Peru State Forest starting at approximately 10 am. Peru State Forest is managed by the Massachusetts Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR) and designated for passive recreation.

**Meet at the Town of Peru parking lot (Rt. 143) on Tuesday, August 15<sup>th</sup> promptly at 8:00 am.** Busses will transport groups from town hall to the trail head at the intersection of Curtin Rd. and Garnet Peak Rd. and back. Be prepared for a rugged and muddy ~1 mile hike. Motorized transport is available for those unable to hike (one-day variance for motorized vehicles). Bring a chair if you would like a seat; the event will be less than an hour.
